

## Challenge

The Hickory Riverwalk project required an elevated boardwalk to connect key landmarks and improve walkability. PermaTrak's team tackled the challenge of aligning the boardwalk with uneven terrain and existing infrastructure while maintaining structural integrity and accessibility. This required careful coordination with the City Walk master plan to ensure the design met both practical needs and aesthetic goals.

As part of the larger Hickory Trail initiative, the boardwalk enhances infrastructure, improves the environment, and contributes to the city's modern, connected design. It also integrates seamlessly into the City Walk master plan, serving as both a practical pathway and a standout feature of Hickory's revitalized downtown.
